They have nevertheless been overlooked by game scholars due to the negative ethical weight of “gambling” - with such games pathologized and labelled as deviance or mental illness, few look beyond to unpick the games, their players, and their communities. communities playing these games, the distinctive cultures and practices that have emerged around them, their activities and beliefs and interpersonal relationships, and how these games influence - both positively and negatively - the lives and careers of millions of game players around the world.
